The purpose of the Chicago Midwest Chapter of the National Association of Health Services Executives (N.A.H.S.E.) Scholarship Program is to promote the advancement and development of African American healthcare leaders and to elevate the quality of healthcare services rendered to underserved communities. Two (2) \$500.00 scholarships will be awarded to undergraduate or graduate students who meet the following criteria for the 2023 - 2024 academic school year.

The scholarship will be presented to the recipient at the 2024 N.A.H.S.E. Chicago Annual Spring Fling Networking Event (March 25th, 2024).

REQUIREMENTS

- Applicant must be enrolled in an accredited college or university program pursuing a bachelor's or master's degree, majoring in Healthcare Administration or other Healthcare related fields (i.e., Public Health, Social Work, Nursing, etc.)
- Applicant must be matriculating during the 2023-2024 academic school year.
- Applicant's Grade point average (GPA) must be a 3.25 or above for undergraduates and a 3.5 or above for graduate candidates. If you are not on a 4.00 scale, make sure your transcript includes a table for conversion.

INSTRUCTIONS

THE FOLLOWING MUST BE ATTACHED TO THE COMPLETED APPLICATION. ALL PACKAGES MUST BE COMPLETE FOR FULL CONSIDERATION.

- A copy of your current resume. Resumes should include employment history, educational accomplishments, extracurricular activities, awards, and honors.
- Headshot (head and shoulders only, in professional attire, i.e., passport photo).
- A transcript from the college or university you are currently attending in pursuit of your degree.
- One (1) letter of recommendation should be received from one of the following individuals: <u>Advisor</u> or <u>faculty member</u> in your major area of study, employer, or a <u>community person</u>. Recommendations from relatives of the applicant are not acceptable.

Guidelines for Scholarship Letters of Recommendation

The letter of recommendation should address the following areas:

- What is your relationship to the applicant and how long have you known him/her?
- Share at least 2-3 personal or professional strengths, qualities or characteristics you would use to describe the applicant that has or will contribute to their success in the future.
- Please describe the applicant's professional promise, in as much detail as possible, share your impression on how the applicant will contribute to future improvements in the healthcare field.
